History Overview – *Castle Life* Year 1 Focus Study



Core Knowledge:

Significant Events 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A siege was when an enemy surrounded a castle so no one could escape and no food could get in. The longest siege in English history took place at Kenilworth Castle a long time ago.
Society 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Castles were built on hills to protect people and to show power. Castles had towers, battlements, thick stone walls and sometimes a moat. Most castles had a great hall, a kitchen, chambers and stables. A king, queen, lord or lady was in charge of a castle. Lots of other people lived and worked in castles doing jobs such as cooks, blacksmiths, soldiers and servants and a priest. Entertainment in castles included banquets, jousting, jesters and falconry.
